OLHSA CARES PROVIDES QUALIFYING RESIDENTS:



FOOD ASSISTANCE

Securing food for those facing food insecurity or having trouble accessing food due to COVID-19.



HOUSING & HOMELESS SUPPORT

Providing support for rental and mortgage assistance.



BURIAL ASSISTANCE

Supporting burial and cremation services for those that have passed due to COVID-19.



EMERGENCY SERVICES

Full COVID-19 support of essential needs determined through needs assessment, including hygiene/personal care and household products.

- Oakland & Livingston County Residents at/or below 200% of federal poverty level.
- People who were impacted by COVID-19.
